Any customer can decide whether to activate or deactivate a new released feature.



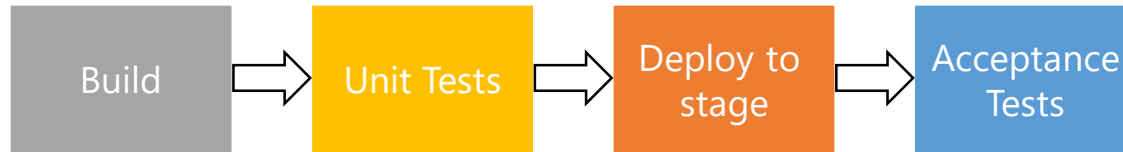
## Editor in all views

The graphical editor is now available in all views. For example a strategy map can be designed manually in the editor.

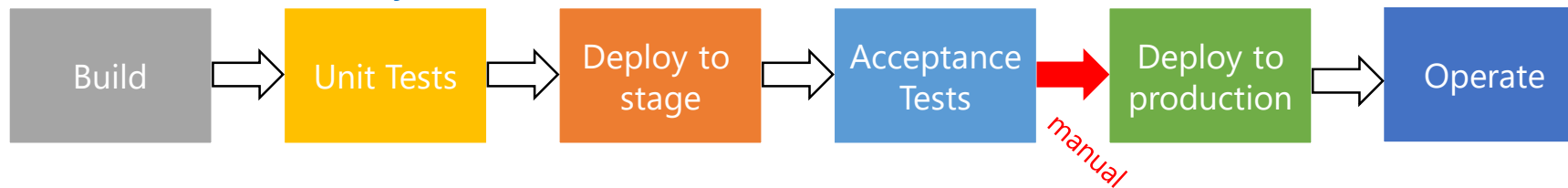
# What is Continuous Delivery?

- We achieve all this by ensuring our code is always in a deployable state, even in the face of different teams of developers making changes on a daily basis.

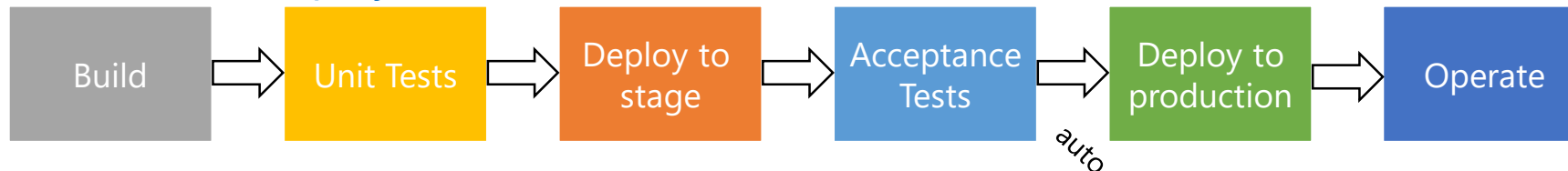
